- Identification of body changes that accompany puberty, which includes a description of the basic structures and functions of the male reproductive system in the boy's presentation.
- Define disease organisms (i.e. viruses [including HIV/AIDS], bacteria, etc.) and how they are transmitted.
- Instruction on decision-making and refusal skills for healthy lifestyle and disease prevention.
- Development of vocabulary that show respect for self and others as guided by the Provo School District's Character Statement.

6th Grade Level Maturation Presentation

The school district approved curriculum instruction, visuals, and any hand-out materials cover the objectives below:

- Demonstrate ability to communicate affection appropriately (touching, hugging).
- Identify behaviors that contribute to healthy body image (posture, hygiene, exercise, diet).
- Recognize fluctuations in emotions and discuss ways of dealing with emotional changes.
- Recognize physical changes that occur during puberty including the reproductive system.
- Description of diseases beginning with infection and how to prevent the spread of infection including HIV and other communicable diseases.
- Instruction on decision-making and refusal skills for obtaining and maintaining a healthy lifestyle as per Provo School District's Character Statement.
