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Application Steps

1. Attend a parent information meeting on February 3, 2010 7:00 p.m. at Edgemont Elementary.
2. Submit the following to Edgemont Elementary by **4:00 p.m. February 19, 2010**:
Dual Immersion Program Application Form (available online at the school web site, the Dual Immersion web page of the Provo District web site or in hard copy at the program school).
3. Submit and *Open Enrollment Form* for out-of-boundary students only to the Student Services Office at Provo School District (280 West 940 North) **by February 19, 2010**. In addition, please submit an *Open Enrollment Form* for each sibling you would like to have attend a traditional class at this school.
4. Obtain a dated copy of the application in person at the school, or if mailing include a self-addressed stamped envelope to receive a dated copy of the application. Your dated copy is your confirmation of receipt of your application. If you fax the application to the school, it must also be received by 4:00 p.m. February 19, 2010. You should keep a copy of the pages you fax for your records; **it is your responsibility to confirm with the school that the application was received.**

Program Sites

These are the dual immersion programs available in Provo School District. Please note that transportation will not be provided for your child unless your child already lives within the school boundaries and is deemed eligible to ride the bus. Dates for information meetings about dual immersion at that school are also listed. All programs are for students entering first grade for the 2010-2011 school year.

Conditions for Placement in the Dual Immersion Program in Provo School District

1. This application does not guarantee enrollment in the program. Students will be selected by lottery for the program, if a lottery is necessary, as indicated on the Provo School District web site.
2. If the child is selected to attend the dual immersion program, it is the responsibility of the parents to provide transportation for the student to and from the school unless the child lives within the school boundaries and is deemed eligible to ride the bus.
3. Research indicates an immersion program is most effective when students remain in the program for a sustained period of time. The student will be expected to continue with the program through sixth grade unless a team decision is made, involving the parent and school staff, that it is in the best interest of the student to have a different placement.
