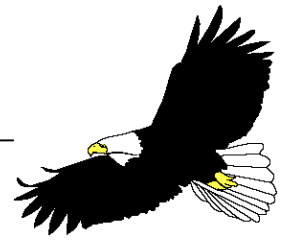

Dear Parent,

Your child's health is important to us. A healthy child is more ready and able to learn than an unhealthy one. We ask your assistance this year in helping your child to stay as healthy as possible. Please provide a nutritious breakfast for your child before he or she comes to school, or encourage your child to eat breakfast at school. Also, if you send a lunch from home with your child, please put nutritious items into it.

We also need to inform you that in accordance with Utah County Health Regulations and our new district wellness policy, you may not send homemade and/or home packaged items to be served or sold at school. This regulation applies to treats you may send for class parties, foods your children may sell for fundraisers, and all other foods in school (except, of course, those foods that you send with and for your own child). Please send only commercially prepared and packaged foods.

Finally, in an effort to make sure your child does not get too many (20-30) treats at one time in school, we are asking that you do not send sweet for your child to exchange with the other children in his/her class except on Valentine's Day. Treats that are brought for exchange on Valentine's Day must be small and commercially wrapped (no unwrapped candy). We invite you to consider non-food items (i.e., stickers, erasure, etc.) instead of candy.

Thank you for helping us to keep your children healthy.
